Families in need of assistance may come to Worth Township and fill out an application form for toys for their children (ages infant to 14 years of age) beginning November 16 until December 11 between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.

You must complete the application and bring in your driver's license/State ID., a birth certificate for each child receiving toys and a copy of your current utility bill. All documents will be verified and documents will be returned.

Applicants must be available to pick up items, *by appointment only*, between Monday, December 11 and Thursday, December 21.

Families in need of warm outerwear this Winter, may also come to the township and select items from our gently used Coats & Outer wear; such as coats, jackets, scarves, mittens, gloves, hats and boots.
