**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES TO BE PAID TO
LABORERS, MECHANICS, AND OTHER WORKERS PERFORMING
CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR WORTH TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Worth Township Road District, Cook County, Illinois (the “Road District”), is a duly organized and existing road district and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et seq.*, the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/1-101, *et seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01, *et seq.*, as amended (the “Act”), which regulates wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by any public body and to anyone under contracts for public works; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the Road District, during the month of June of each year, to investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of the Road District; and

WHEREAS, IDOL’s most current prevailing wage rates were issued effective September 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Worth Township Highway Commissioner (the “Commissioner”) has determined that it is in the best interests of the Road District to adopt IDOL’s revised prevailing rate of wages for Cook County, Illinois, as the prevailing rate of wages for the construction of public works for the Road District (the “Determination”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Highway Commissioner of Worth Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The statements set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Ordinance as if set forth in full.

Section 2. To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in the Road District for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in the construction of public works for the Road District is ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for Cook County, Illinois, as determined by IDOL effective September 1, 2017, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A. As required by the Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages made by IDOL shall supersede the Road District’s

current Determination for the construction of public works for the Road District. Nothing herein shall be construed to apply the general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works for the Road District to the extent required by the Act.

Section 3. The Worth Township Clerk, as the *ex officio* clerk of the Road District, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to: (a) publicly post the Determination and keep it available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Road District; (b) promptly (and in no event later than July 15, 2018) file a certified copy of this Ordinance and the Determination with IDOL; (c) within thirty (30) days after filing with the IDOL, publish notice of the Determination, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Road District; and (d) promptly mail a copy of the Determination to any employer, to any association of employers, and to any person or association of employees who have filed or who file their names and addresses with the Road District, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.


Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

Section 5. All Road District, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after passage and approval.



NOTICE OF WORTH TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT'S PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATION

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01, *et seq.* (the "Act"), the Highway Commissioner of Worth Township, Cook County, Illinois (the "Commissioner"), has adopted and approved Ordinance No. 498-18 (the "Ordinance"), which sets forth the prevailing rate of wages, as defined in the Act, for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of the Worth Township Road District (the "Road District") employed in the construction of public works for the Road District. The Commissioner's determination of the prevailing rate of wages in accordance with the Act (the "Determination") is effective and copies of the Ordinance and the Determination are available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Township, which is located at 11601 S. Pulaski Road, Alsip, Illinois. The prevailing wage rates for the Road District are the same as those determined by the Illinois Department of Labor for Cook County, Illinois. The Determination will be mailed to any employer, to any association of employers, and to any person or association of employees who have filed or who file their names and addresses with the Road District, requesting copies of the Determination.


