Built in 1927, the train operates on the original Milwaukee Electric Railway Company's inter-urban track and takes a leisurely trip to Phantom Lake, before returning to the East Troy depot and museum. On our way back we will stop at the landmark Elegant Farmer Farm Market. You'll have time here to shop at their Farm Kitchen Bakery and Market featured on TV's Food Network. The market is known for its one-of-a-kind apple pie baked in a paper bag!
