Worth Township will be hosting a girls volleyball league for 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade players. The league will play 4 days a week (Monday–Thursday) from November 12, 2024, thru March of 2024.

A mandatory Girls Volleyball League – Coach's Meeting will take place on Wednesday October 16th, 2024, at 6:00pm inside our big gym at the Worth Township Building. This meeting will register your teams.

We are requesting that all coordinators and coaches bring any dates to this meeting that may cause any play conflict so we can do the best we can to create a schedule without rescheduling.
